\*What consultant put together this mailer? Does he or she also work for the mayoral campaign?

\*What does Mark's experience targeting drug-dealing and clearing large encampments have to do with Prop. D?

\*What does our leaders having failed us since Farrell left office have to do with Prop. D?

\*What does Mark being a Democrat have to do with Prop. D?

\*Would you characterize the quotes on this side of the mailer as discussing Mark's qualifications to be elected mayor and London Breed's qualifications to not be re-elected?

\*Finally, glancing at California Code, Government Code - GOV § 82025, it states that a communication is not advocacy if it "does not take a position on the character, qualifications, or fitness for office of a candidate or officeholder."

How does the language on this side of of the mailer — the "wearing a tie" side — adhere to these regulations?
