

1. **Does SFHP feel concerned about the possible cuts to Medicaid? If so, Why?**

At San Francisco Health Plan (SFHP), we believe that everyone has the right to health care. The federal government's \$1.1 trillion cut in health care funding puts the well-being of 14 million Medi-Cal members across the state at risk.

2. **As of today, how many people in San Francisco are enrolled in Medicaid?**

There are more than 238,000 Medi-Cal members in San Francisco. As the city's number one choice for Medi-Cal, SFHP has 180,000 members.

3. **Do you have an estimation on how many people may lose coverage in San Francisco because of the cuts?**

We expect SFHP's Medi-Cal enrollment to decrease by 17,896 members over the next fiscal year.

4. **Do you have any comments on the possible impact on neighborhood clinics and hospitals?**

Right now, we are all working to understand the full scope and implications of these federal cuts. We have strong relationships with neighborhood clinics and hospitals across the city, and are committed to working with our providers, advocates and leaders on strategies that will protect health care access for our 180,000 members and all San Franciscans.

5. **Do these cuts affect undocumented folks especially badly? Are you able to provide the number of folks who are undocumented and enrolled in Medi-Cal in San Francisco?**

As of June 2025, we have 44,632 members who are classified as UIS.
