



1 Buildings here are slowly tipping backwards into the marshland underneath.

2 The Armory. A small tributary of the Arroyo Dolores runs through its basement. It was built on this site precisely so that the army would have a ready supply of water in case the city rioted against them.

3 Former site of the Atlas Home Laundry linen cleaning service, one of the last buildings to use city water. It routinely drew 10,000 gallons of groundwater per day.

4 Once a Pepsi bottling plant, now the Mission Police Station. The bottling plant was built here to take its water supply directly from the ground.

5 In the 1850's this was the site of a beer garden called the Willows. It also took advantage of the Mission's ample water supply.

6 First sidewalk torn up by Plant SF.
