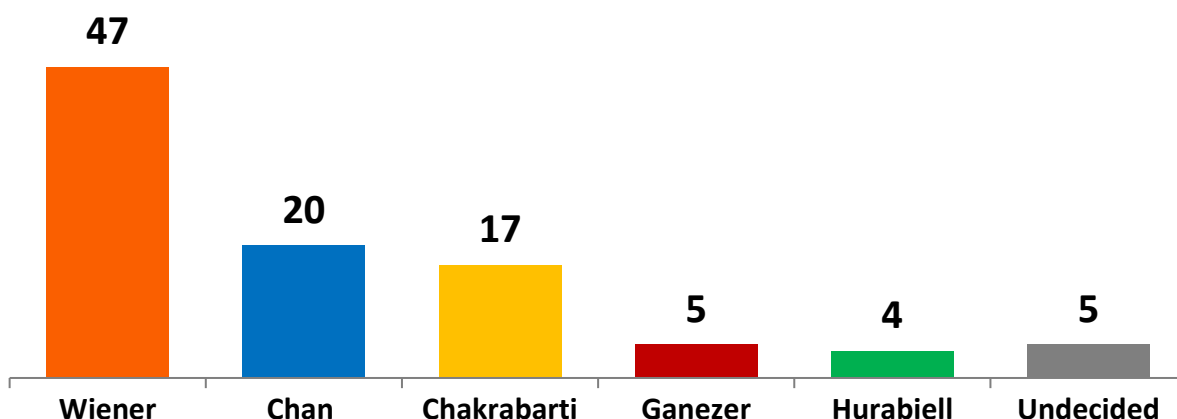

 Re: New Polling in CA-11 Congressional Race

A new Lake Research Partners poll of likely 2026 primary voters in California’s 11th Congressional District¹ shows Connie Chan in a strong position to advance to the general election, gaining ground and currently in second place on the primary ballot. Chan also holds a significant favorability advantage over Saikat Chakrabarti despite Chakrabarti’s massive campaign spending to date.

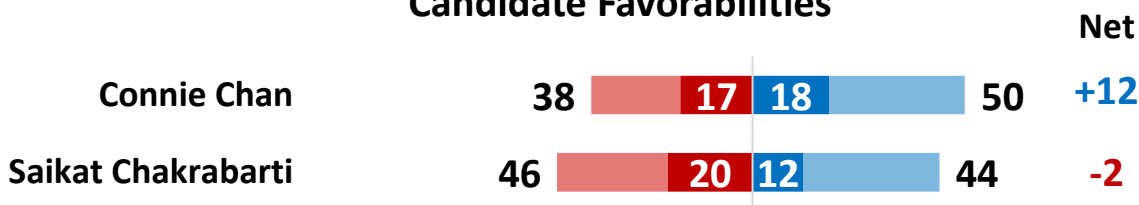
While Scott Wiener remains the frontrunner in the primary, Chan is ahead in the race for second place. Chan, with 20% of the vote, currently leads Saikat Chakrabarti (17%), with other candidates in the low single digits. Only 5% of voters are undecided at this point in the race.

CA-11 Congressional Primary Ballot



Connie Chan has solidly net-favorable ratings (+12). Half of the electorate is favorable towards her, so she has the opportunity to convert favorability into support on the ballot. In contrast, Saikat Chakrabarti has higher negatives and a net-negative rating (-2).

¹ Lake Research Partners conducted a poll of 500 likely 2026 primary election voters in CA-11. Live telephone interviews (cell and landline) and text-to-online interviews were conducted from April 29 – May 3, 2026, in English and Cantonese. Data are weighted slightly to reflect the likely demographic profile of the likely 2026 electorate. The margin of error for the full sample is +/- 4.4%.
