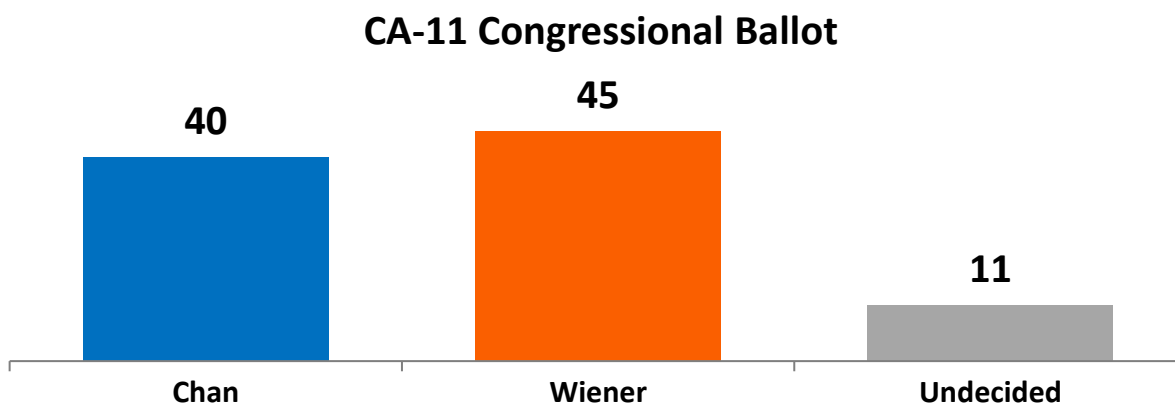

Re: New Polling in CA-11 Congressional Race

A new Lake Research Partners poll of likely 2026 general election voters in California's 11th Congressional Districtⁱ shows a close race between Connie Chan and Scott Wiener, with Chan gaining momentum since the primary.

After trailing by 11 points in the primary, Chan has closed the gap with Wiener to just 5 points, with 40% of the vote to his 45%. Just over one in ten voters (11%) are still undecided at this point in the race. Compared to the June primary results, Chan has gained more than twice as much new support (+10 points) as Wiener has (+4).



Connie Chan's momentum is growing, and with endorsements from nurses, firefighters, teachers, and CA-11 incumbent Nancy Pelosi, she is in a strong position to overtake Wiener and win in November.

ⁱ Lake Research Partners conducted a poll of 500 likely November 2026 voters with an oversample of 100 Chinese American likely voters in CA-11. Live telephone interviews (cell and landline) and text-to-online interviews were conducted from July 14-19, 2026, in English and Cantonese. Data are weighted to reflect the demographic profile of the likely 2026 electorate. The margin of error for the full sample is +/- 4.4%.
