

No. A searchable record of where people travel can reveal visits to LGBTQ+ spaces, healthcare providers, religious institutions, or immigrant-serving organizations. In just six months, outside agencies ran over 1.6 million searches of San Francisco's plate data, including 19 for ICE. Even after shutting down that access, improper outside searches continued.

Evidence also hasn't shown that Flock reduces crime. A system that doesn't offer security or results isn't working for us.

SFPD's \$3.9 million contract expires in February 2027; I'd vote against renewal.

I'd invest instead in well-lit streets, vibrant storefronts, after-dark programming, and street crisis response teams to deliver safety we can feel without sacrificing privacy.
